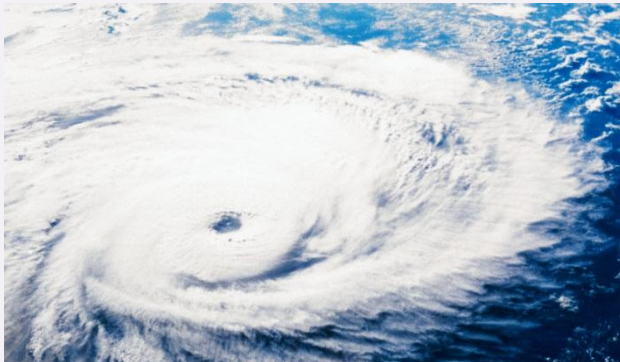

**Victims of Hurricane Sandy can apply  
for D-SNAP January 7-13 at either:**

- Somerset County DSS, 30397 Mt. Vernon Road, Princess Anne or
- Disaster Recovery Center, Lower Somerset County Ambulance & Rescue Squad Building, 2 Mill Lane, Crisfield

D-SNAP applications accepted 8 am - 7 pm  
Monday - Saturday and 1-5 pm Sunday.

- Apply for D-SNAP (Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance) - a 30 day food benefit for eligible storm victims not already receiving SNAP/FSP/Food Stamps benefits
- Pick up perishable and non-perishable foods donated by the Maryland Food Bank while supplies last
- Apply for Food Supplement Program (formerly known as the Food Stamp Program) and Energy Assistance
